Easter Triduum (Latin: *Triduum Paschale*), **Holy Triduum** (Latin: *Triduum Sacrum*), **Paschal Triduum**, or **The Three Days** is the period of three days that begins with the liturgy on the evening of **Maundy Thursday** (Holy Thursday) and ends with Evening Prayer on Easter Sunday. It recalls the **passion, death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus**, as portrayed in the **canonical Gospels**.
